

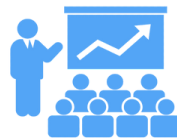

- Importance of the Banksman's role ,checking the cargo manifest and reviewing the load
- Checking the load for dropped objects , balance and security of the load
- Difficulties that might occur during the lifting and moving operations
- Need for high visibility vests , communicating hand signals clearly
- What is meant by 'line of sight' and a 'blind lift' , the hand signal for 'emergency stop'
- Establishing and using two way radio communications
- Different types of slings and sling identification markings
- Principles of sling angles and tensions , using appropriate lifting accessories
- Attaching slings to ensure a safe and even weight distribution
- Protecting slings from damage , unhooking and removing slings and disconnection of lifting equipment
- Securing the cargo within a container/half height using ratchet straps
- Selection and use of correct PPE , use of hand signals and radio communications
