- Conduct BA operations in accordance with HLO directions and safe practices.
- Conduct firefighting operations effectively using fixed and mobile equipment.
- Update HLO on progress against the plan at appropriate times.
- Under direction from the HLO: respond to non-fire helideck emergencies.
